




One in the front and one in the back




17. OCULI NOSTRI Our Eyes are Turned

Additional Healing Prayer Available

At times when we pray for healing, by God's grace, we experience amazing results right away. We might experience pain disappearing or a burden lifted from our heart in a way that we feel we are forever transformed - or we might even see a physical transformation before our eyes. These are signs that proclaim Christ's good news: "The kingdom of God is at hand". Often, however, healing will take place over time, with continuing in-depth prayer. Successful healing ministries, and Jesus Himself, admonish us to continue to pray over time, calling upon the Holy Spirit to penetrate more fully and deeply for ongoing healing.
